

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

I. RESERVATION

Upon confirmation of the tour, reservation must be made by filling out the reservation form which will be provided by China Custom Tours.

II. PAYMENTS

a. Deposit – \$300 per person is required at the time of confirmation of the reservation. In some tours, deposit is made by paying the full amount of the transpacific air tickets, as the airlines can hold air reservation for a limited time only.

b. Deposit may be paid by credit or by check. If payment is made by credit card, a properly filled out authorization form supplied by China Custom Tours should be submitted by the tour participant.

c. Final Payment – due 70 days prior to departure date.

d. Late Payment – a fee of \$50 will be added to tour cost if final payment is not received 70 days prior to departure date.

e. Late Booking – a fee of \$50 will be assessed to all bookings made within 45 -14 days prior to departure date.

f. Revision – a \$20 fee per person shall be applied on any changes made, including addition or deletion of services, changes in air and /or land arrangements (plus supplier's penalties). Once documents / tickets are issued, changes are not permitted. Revision fee is in addition to any rebooking fees.

g. For some tour packages with air reservations, the client may be required to make immediate payment for air tickets to secure airline seats, after deposit for tour has been made.

III. CANCELLATION

A. Package Group Tours

- a. 75 days or more before departure date: \$300
- b. 74-45 days prior to departure date: \$400
- c. 44-16 days prior to departure date: \$600
- d. 15-1 days prior to departure date: 50% of the tour fare
- e. On or after departure date (including no shows): 100% of the tour fare

B. Customized Tours

Upon receipt and confirmation of our proposed customized itinerary, a deposit of \$300 is required. This amount forms in part of payment and is deductible from the total tour fare. In the event, a cancellation takes place, the deposit is NON-REFUNDABLE.

In the event of that tickets for airlines, cruises or trains have already been issued or final confirmation have been received at the time of cancellation (regardless of the number of days prior to departure), each tour participant will be assessed additional cancellation penalties and service charges in accordance to the rules and regulations of the tour operator.

IV. TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

A. Passport and Visa – to enter and leave China, all tour participants must be in possession of a valid passport and Chinese visa. Upon request, China Custom Tours will be happy to secure your visa for a fee of \$160.00 each. Together with a properly filled out application form and an official passport -sized color photo, your passport should be sent to our office at leave 45 days before the departure date. A passport must have 6 months validity AFTER the date of return.

B. Travel Insurance – is optional but highly recommended to any tour participant. Truth is, no matter how we try to provide a smooth and hassle-free trip, unavoidable circumstances pay take place before or even during your trip. Thus, we recommend purchase of travel insurance. Please contact us for more information.

C. Health – neither health certificate nor inoculations is required for entry into China. Any physical or mental disability requiring special attention must be noted at the time of booking the tour. China Custom Tours reserves the right to excluded participants who are physically or mentally ill before or during the tour.

D. Baggage – at your risk throughout the trip. Baggage allowance differs from the transpacific and China sections of your tour.

Carry-On Luggage – Each passenger is allowed one carry-on by the dimensions of which should not exceed 25 inches by length. Valuables, passports, insurance policies, air tickets; and medications should be carried with you at all times. Most of the hotels offer safety deposit box for your valuables free of charge (or for everything except passports). Please check with hotel front desk for details and make sure you retrieve your things from the safe deposit box before you leave the hotel.

Check-In Luggage – Passengers can have 2 pieces of check-in luggage for Trans-Pacific flights; each can weigh up to 50 lbs. However, for China domestic flights, the maximum allowance is 44 lbs. for check -in baggage for each passenger. So we urge our passengers to carry only one piece of luggage each for check-in. If your luggage is overweight, you will pay around \$1USD for every pound in excess. Locks are required on all check-in luggage for domestic flights in China.

E. Money Exchange – please bring travelers checks and some cash with you. Major credit cards are accepted at the hotels (and their attaché restaurants and shops) and Friendship

Stores. Bank of China maintains exchange at virtually all tourist spots (hotels, airports, and railway stations and friendship stores from strangers as it is against the currency exchange regulation of China).

F. Clothing – casual clothes and comfortable walking shoes are recommended. No formal dress is required for the evening performances.

G. Electricity & Water – all twin-bedded rooms are furnished with private bath in Western style. Electric current is 220 volts, 50 cycles. As adapters are not always available, we suggest you bring your own two and three prong adapters/converters for your personal electrical appliances (some hotels have round prongs and some have flat prongs). Tap water is not drinkable in China (except hotels equipped with extra purification equipment). However, some hotels provide 2 bottles of water free of charge, in each hotel room, a boiler is available. Bottled water (mineral water or distilled) is readily available in hotel lobbies and large food shops.

V. GENERAL CONDITIONS

A. Unused portions of the Tour – any unused part of the tour, including portions of land arrangements, hotel accommodations, or any other feature of the tour, is non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

B. Tour Price – Tour Prices are based on current exchange rate and fuel surcharges at the time of brochure printing, and are subject to change.

Flight schedule and tour changes which require additional nights and costs in addition to the booked tour package will be assessed to each tour participant.

C. Travel Insurance Fee – is non-refundable. Notice of claim must be made in writing within 14 days of the tour termination.

D. Traveling with Children – charges for children vary depending on the tour package that is purchased.

On some tours, 75% of the tour fare shall be applied to any child whose age is 11 years old or under. This is in the condition that the child will share room with his/her parents and will not ask for extra bed. In the event that an extra bed is needed, 90% of the tour fare shall be applied accordingly.

There are other tours wherein discount is not extended regardless of the agent of the child. This is for the reason that tour operators have their own set of terms and conditions. We, as a travel agent, must abide by these guidelines. Traveling with children is treated on a case to case basis.

E. Passenger Names – it is the responsibility of the tour participant to submit his/her name, as it appears on the passport. A photocopy of your passport is required upon reservation of tour.

A revision fee will be charged if name must be changed within 75 days prior to departure date. Charges are also subject to airline penalties. China Custom Tours is not responsible for any ticket re-issue charges or denial of boarding by an airline due to name discrepancy.

F. Meals – full American or buffet breakfast; Chinese or western dinners at local restaurant or onboard the cruise ship.

G. Travel Documents – all travel documents will be sent 14 days prior to departure.

VI. RESPONSIBILITY

China Custom Tours, as a travel agency, acts only as an agent for contracted services. All Travel arrangements included in this trip are made on participants behalf upon the express conditions that neither the tour operators nor China Custom Tours, shall be held liable or responsible for any losses or expenses, default of any third parties, sickness, weather, strike, acts of GOD, acts of terrorism, force majeure, acts of government's civil disturbances, war, quarantine, customs regulations, epidemics, criminal activity or for any other cause beyond its control.

Third party refers to airline, train, motor coach, private car, cruise vessel, boat, or any other conveyance, hotel, sightseeing provider, local ground-handler, etc., which is to (or does) supply any goods or services for this trip.

All tickets, coupons or receipts issued by China Custom Tours and all arrangements for transport or conveyance or for hotel accommodations are made by China Custom Tours as an agent of the suppliers. By utilizing the services of the suppliers, you agree that China Custom Tours shall not be held liable for any injury, damage, loss, accident or delay incurred by you or those traveling with you in connection with any accommodations, transportation, or other services resulting directly from any acts or default of the suppliers or from any occurrence or condition, including defects in vehicles or breakdown in equipment.

All such losses or expenses have to be borne and paid for by the participant.

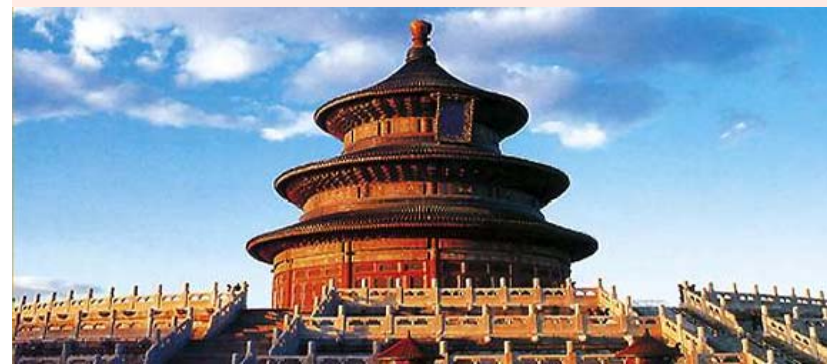
